Update from Mylo Allen, Principal

- 1. Received playground equipment will be installed over the next two weeks. There will be synthetic turf tiles. Playground updates in weekly assembly video.
- 2. Gym on North Side of school had work done
- 3. Parent/Teacher conferences went well and were well attended.
- 4. Questions:

Is Covid Testing being offered at Parkview? There was testing being offered at Parkview on M,T,Th. Testing has been moved to Shuksan - (FRC) Family Resource Center. The district is working on a pilot program to give schools the resources to administer/offer rapid covid tests onsite. Details are not confirmed.

Will vaccination clinics be offered at the school? - 1st wave kids will get through health care providers & clinics, 2nd wave will be setting up clinics at schools, not sure of the timeline.

Outdoor Lunch - is this an option for students? Yes, There is a tent set-up outside that has four picnic tables and the covered area. Classes rotate between indoor and outdoor lunch.

Field Trips 2021 -2022 School Year - Currently field trips that are within covid safe guidelines and held outside are possible. The status of field trips also is dependent on the type of field trip. Many organizations switched to an online model due to Covid and have not returned to in person events and activities.

- Salmon Field Trips Cornwall Park possible this year. Salmon Tank returning to school in approximately two weeks.
- Salish Sea (4th grade) would need to see what happens with Covid 19. Possible to be held this year if it can be done safely.
- Mountain School (5th grade)- North Cascades Institute must decide to offer in person Mountain School. Most likely will not return to in person field trip this year.
